The Tuli are true indigenous cattle. They are descendants of the Sanga cattle brought into Southern Africa by migrating tribes circa 700AD. As the centuries passed, only the best cattle survived through selection by nature, and became very adaptable to harsh conditions. This makes them very suitable for farming in extensive environments.

In 1946 Mr Len Harvey, a Land Development Officer in the former Southern Rhodesia, saw these good qualities in the local cattle. He then urged the government to buy a basic breeding herd of highly fertile Tswana-type cattle with good milking qualities from local tribesmen and started to upgrade them to the Tuli cattle we know today.

- Medium sized with a smooth coat
- Cows have nearly picture perfect udders
- Docile nature
- Bulls mate until they are 10 years and older
- Cows calf until they are 15 years and older
- Early maturing cattle
